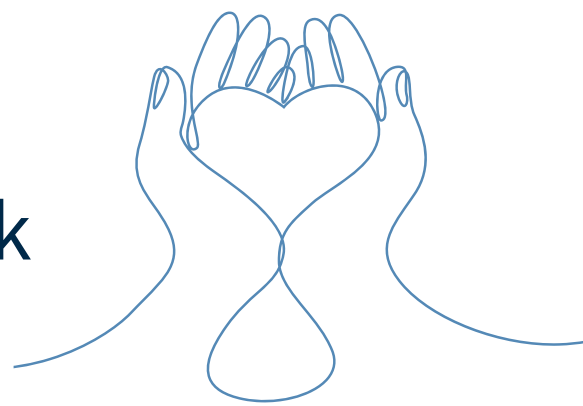


2023: Our year in giving back

RUTH ECKERD HALL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

\$500,000 contributed

Funds support upgrades to auditorium and classroom technology, public safety and security, and visitor amenities, as well as new educational programming.

RAYMOND JAMES PRESENTS: MIDDLE SCHOOL ARTS

This new on-site and in-the-classroom learning program will address the gap in arts education for sixth-to-eighth-grade students, starting in 2024. It is expected to reach 2,000 to 5,000 students in the Tampa Bay area annually.
