- **Common scams with a COVID-19 twist:** A fraudster will try to create a sense of urgency or fear. Common storylines involve someone you know or love having been in an accident or arrested. During the pandemic, storylines have been altered to include someone in need of money because they are trapped in a quarantined location, unable to travel.
